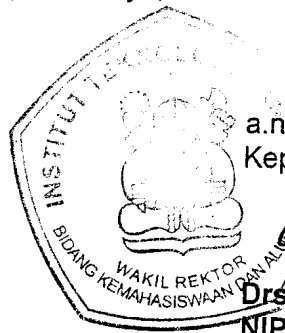

## International TOEFL® and Institutional TOEFL® (TOEFL® ITP)

The Test of English as a Foreign Language™ (TOEFL®) is a standardized test recognized worldwide. It measures the English proficiency of people whose native language is not English.

The TOEFL® test consists of two kinds: *International TOEFL®* and *Institutional Testing Program (TOEFL® ITP)*. Before deciding which TOEFL® test to take, people should carefully decide what purpose they will use the score for.

Students who need TOEFL scores for admission to universities and colleges should take the *International TOEFL*. Since April 2006, the format of International TOEFL has changed into the *internet-Based Testing (iBT)* which consists of: Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing.

*The Institutional Testing Program (TOEFL® ITP)* differs from the other TOEFL testing program because it gives qualified institutions and agencies the opportunity to administer the TOEFL® test on their own and to use their own facilities and staff. Since TOEFL® ITP is not a fully secure test, the scores should not be used for university admission or other high stakes purposes, but they are reported only to the institutions requiring.

Each year, more than 1,500 institutions and agencies from around the globe administer more than 350,000 ITP tests using their staff and facilities.

In Indonesia, TOEFL® ITP is organized by *The Indonesian International Education Foundation - IIEF*, the ETS official representative.

## How to take TOEFL® ITP?

### For Institutions

Any institutions interested in conducting TOEFL® ITP must complete the Application Form and submit it to IIEF at least **14 (fourteen) working days prior to the requested test date**. The minimum order is **10 (ten) participants for one test administration**. To ensure prompt and accurate delivery of orders, all information requested on the application form must be provided.

All test fees must be paid according to the terms indicated on the test use application. **All used and unused test materials must be returned and test fees must be paid before additional orders are filled.**

### For Individuals

Individuals interested in taking TOEFL® ITP should contact IIEF to find out which institutions or language centers conduct TOEFL® ITP in their city. **INDIVIDUALS MUST BE AWARE OF THOSE INSTITUTIONS OFFERING UNOFFICIAL "INSTITUTIONAL TOEFL TEST".**

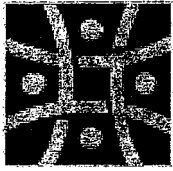

## INFORMASI BEASISWA IFP

Ford Foundation, sebuah lembaga nirlaba yang mengabdikan untuk perdamaian dunia dan kesejahteraan umat manusia, telah meluncurkan International Fellowships Program (IFP). Secara garis besar, tujuan-tujuan Ford Foundation adalah memperkuat nilai-nilai demokratis, mengurangi kemiskinan dan ketidakadilan, mendukung kerjasama internasional, dan meningkatkan karya manusia.

Tujuan IFP adalah membantu individu yang memiliki potensi kepemimpinan dan berkomitmen untuk membantu kelompok masyarakat yang kurang memiliki akses dan/atau berasal dari kelompok tersebut. Individu-individu tersebut diberi kesempatan untuk melanjutkan studi di program pascasarjana.

Di Indonesia, IFP dikelola oleh IIEF (The Indonesian International Education Foundation), sebuah lembaga pendidikan nirlaba yang bergerak di bidang pengembangan dan pertukaran pendidikan serta pelatihan, yang bertujuan menumbuhkan rasa saling pengertian antarbangsa.

Sebelum memulai studi, apabila diperlukan, penerima beasiswa akan memperoleh orientasi dan persiapan studi, misalnya kursus bahasa dan komputer, sesuai dengan kebutuhannya.

### Siapa saja yang Memenuhi Syarat untuk Memperoleh Beasiswa IFP di Indonesia

IFP menyediakan bantuan untuk studi pascasarjana (Master atau Doktoral) bagi anggota masyarakat yang kurang memiliki kesempatan untuk menempuh pendidikan tinggi, antara lain penduduk yang tinggal di daerah terpencil, masyarakat adat, masyarakat terpinggirkan, atau masyarakat yang berada di daerah konflik/pascakonflik.

Pelamar harus memiliki kewarganegaraan Indonesia dan bertempat tinggal di Indonesia. Persyaratan lainnya yang harus dipenuhi pelamar, yaitu:

- telah menyelesaikan program studi Sarjana/S1 dengan prestasi yang sangat baik,
- berperan aktif dalam masyarakat atau komunitasnya,
- memiliki rencana kerja untuk menerapkan apa yang akan dipelajarinya sesuai dengan tujuan-tujuan Ford Foundation, dan
- memiliki komitmen untuk melaksanakan rencana kerja itu setelah menyelesaikan masa studinya.

### Proses Pendaftaran

Semua berkas pendaftaran harus diserahkan ke IIEF untuk kemudian diperiksa dan dinilai oleh panel seleksi nasional dan daerah yang para anggotanya terdiri dari para pakar dan praktisi di berbagai bidang akademik.

### Jadwal Pendaftaran dan Seleksi untuk Indonesia

IIEF menerima pendaftaran untuk beasiswa IFP sepanjang tahun. Formulir Pra Pendaftaran paling lambat harus diterima pada setiap tanggal *1 Agustus (cap pos)*.

- Pelamar yang lulus ke tahap seleksi pendaftaran akan diberikan formulir pendaftaran lengkap. Pemberitahuan akan diumumkan pada tanggal 30 September.
- Seleksi uji kemampuan bahasa pada bulan Februari dan wawancara akan diadakan antara bulan April.
- Penerima beasiswa akan diumumkan sekitar bulan Agustus.
- Penerima beasiswa akan mulai menempuh program studinya pada tahun akademik berikutnya.

Formulir prapendaftaran yang diterima *setelah 1 Agustus (cap pos)* akan diproses untuk periode seleksi berikutnya.

The APLP is a signature program of the East-West Center. Graduates leave the East-West Center with an expansive Asia Pacific regional perspective. APLP alumni are navigators of change in the Asia Pacific.
